# Son of God

#### John 17:1

After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you.

#### John 17:2

For you granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those you have given him.

#### John 17:3

Now this is eternal life: that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

## Messiah

#### John 4:25

The woman said, "I know that Messiah" (called Christ) "is coming. When he comes, he will explain everything to us."

By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but him who sent me.

Jesus is not... Omnipotent

#### Matthew 28:18

Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me." Jesus is not... Omniscient



# Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

#### Mark 13:32

But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. Jesus is not... Self-sufficient

#### Luke 22:42

# "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done."

## God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it.

Jesus is not... equal with God

#### John 14:28

You heard me say, 'I am going away and I am coming back to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

So, because Jesus was doing these things on the Sabbath, the Jewish leaders began to persecute him.

In his defense Jesus said to them, "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working."

For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God.

# Resurrection

#### John 5:28-29

Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out

John 5:28-29

those who have done what is good will rise to live, and those who have done what is evil will rise to be condemned.

Jesus promised... blessings

#### Matthew 6:33

But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Jesus promised... eternal life

#### John 10:27-28

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand.

Jesus promised... forgiveness

#### Matthew 6:14

For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. Jesus promised... rewards

#### Matthew 16:27

For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done.

... listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know.

This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.

But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.

"... I can tell you confidently that the patriarch David died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day.

But he was a prophet and knew that God had promised him on oath that he would place one of his descendants on his throne.

Seeing what was to come, he spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, that he was not abandoned to the realm of the dead, nor did his body see decay.

### God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it.

**Exalted to the right hand of** God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear.

# 34 For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said,

The Lord [God] said to my Lord [Messiah]: "Sit at my right hand

#### Acts 2:34-35

# The Lord [God] said to my Lord [Messiah]:

"Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet.""

Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah."

When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"

Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off — for all whom the Lord our God will call."

With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation."

Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.
