John 17:1

After **Jesus** said this, he looked toward heaven and **prayed**: “**Father**, the hour has come. Glorify **your Son**, that your Son may glorify you.

John 17:2

For you granted him
authority over all people that
he might give **eternal life** to
all those you have given him.

John 17:3

Now this is **eternal life**: that they know you, the only true **God**, and **Jesus** Christ, whom you have sent.

John 4:25

Then Jesus declared, “I, the one speaking to you—I am he.”

Acts 2:36

“Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: **God** has **made** this **Jesus**, whom you crucified, both Lord and **Messiah.**”

Savior

Acts 13:22

After removing Saul, he made David their king. God testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do.'

Acts 13:23

“From this man’s
descendants **God** has
brought to Israel the **Savior**
Jesus, as he promised.

Mediator

1 Timothy 2:5-6

For there is **one God** and one **mediator** between God and mankind, the **man Christ Jesus**, who gave himself as a ransom for all people.

High Priest

Hebrews 4:14

Therefore, since we have a
great **high priest** who has
ascended into heaven, **Jesus**
the Son of God, let us hold
firmly to the faith we profess

John 5:19

Jesus gave them this answer:
“Very truly I tell you, the **Son**
can do **nothing** by **himself**...

John 5:19

John 5:30

Mark 13:31

Heaven and earth will pass
away, but my words will
never pass away.

Mark 13:32

But about that day or hour no one knows, not even the **angels** in heaven, nor the **Son**, but only the **Father**.

Self-sufficient

Luke 22:42

“Father, **if** you are **willing**,
take this cup from me; yet
not my will, but yours be
done.”

Acts 2:32

God has **raised** this **Jesus** to

Jesus is not...
equal with God

John 14:28

You heard me say, 'I am going away and I am coming back to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the **Father is greater than I.**

John 5:16

So, because Jesus was doing these things on the **Sabbath**, the **Jewish leaders** began to **persecute** him.

John 5:17

In his defense Jesus said to them, “My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working.”

John 5:18

For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself **equal** with God.

Jesus gave them this answer:

For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to **save** the world through him.

Resurrection

John 5:28-29

Do not be amazed at this, for

Jesus promised...
rewards

Matthew 16:27

For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he **will reward** each person according to what they have done.

Acts 2:22

... listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know.

Acts 2:23

This **man** was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to **death** by nailing him to the cross.

Acts 2:24

But **God raised him** from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.

Acts 2:29

“... I can tell you confidently that the patriarch **David** died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day.

Acts 2:30

But he was a prophet and knew that God had promised him on oath that he would place one of his **descendants** on his **throne**.

Acts 2:31

Seeing what was to come, he spoke of the **resurrection** of the **Messiah**, that he was not abandoned to the realm of the dead, nor did his body see decay.
